HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF MATHIS MATHIS TOWING POLICY

The Housing Authority of the City of Mathis will enforce the following policy in removal of vehicles that are illegally parked or parked in otherwise designated areas.

The owner/operator of a vehicle may not at any time leave a vehicle unattended on the property that obstructs a gate that is intended for use by pedestrians or vehicles; obstructs pedestrian or vehicular access to an area that is used for the placement of a garbage or refuse receptacle that is used in common by residents of the apartment complex; is in or obstructs a restricted parking area or parking designated for residents, maintenance, management or otherwise marked clearly as a designated parking space; is in a designated tow away zone; is a semitrailer, trailer, or truck-tractor, unless the owner or operator of the vehicle is permitted by the Housing Authority to park on the property; or is leaking fluid that presents a hazard or threat to persons or property.

The Housing Authority will not have a vehicle towed that has an invalid inspection certificate of registration without proper notification. The Housing Authority will give ten (10) days notice to the owner or operator of the vehicle, delivered in person. If the Authority is unable to deliver the notice in person the notice will be mailed certified, return receipt requested to the owner or operator of the vehicle.

The Housing Authority will place the appropriate signage at each entrance of the Housing Authority property and will follow rules applicable to signage in accordance with Texas House Bill No. 2094, Subchapter G.
